Arid Gujarat

- Farmers are advised to dry harvested produce of wheat, cumin, mustard & coriander crops upto 8-10 % moisture level and store in moisture free area to avoid further loss of produce.
- Farmers are advised to undertake light and regular irrigation in summer green gram at 6- 8 days interval for good growth.
- Application of well powdered gypsum @ 250 kg/ha as a top dressing at full blooming stage and immediate irrigation is recommended in summer groundnut for good yields.
- Farmers are advised to perform hand pollination and give irrigation at appropriate time/stage in date palm for better fruit harvest.
- The regular irrigation in mango may be undertaken to avoid soil moisture stress at fruit setting stage.
- The farmers are advised to perform regular medium irrigation in pomegranate orchard to get better hast bahar for quality fruit yields.
