Arid Gujarat

1. Farmers of the region are advised to apply irrigation in wheat crop at milking and dough stage.
2. Sulphar dust & karathane are advised as precautionary measure to prevent the possible attack of powdery mildew in cumin crop.
3. To avoid the seed shattering problem in mustard crop, farmers are advised for harvesting at proper stage.
4. Farmers are advised to take the sowing of summer groundnut, whenever night minimum temperature goes above 18⁰ C.
5. Regular irrigations are advised in date palm after initiation of inflorescence to avoid soil moisture stress.
6. Pomegranate is now in fruiting stage, so regular irrigations are advised to avoid soil moisture stress and fruit cracking problem in pomegranate.
