Agro-advisory for Western Rajasthan February, 2013

Agronomical practices:

- Farmers are advised to control of powdery mildew in mustard and cumin crop through spray of wettable sulphur @ 3 g/litre water at the onset of disease and repeat after 15 days, if required.
- Advised for cumin crop growing farmers for avoiding damage their crop to Aphid, they can spray of monocrotophos @ 1ml/1liter water.
- Farmers are suggested to spray of malathion 50 E.C. 1litre/ha with 400-450 litre water for control of aphid in mustard crop.
- Farmers are suggested for early sown mustard crop, if mustard crop has matured then harvest in morning time.
- Farmers are advised to give third or fourth irrigation in wheat crops if have sufficient irrigation facility.
- Farmers have irrigation facility in summer season they can start field preparation of early summer vegetable crops for taking good economic benefit.

Livestock:

- ❖ Farmers are advised for livestock protection from cold weather to close type animal shelter with north side covered and optimum ventilation and animals as well as shelter should be exposed to sunlight
