Farmer's training on Good Agricultural Practices on Cumin and Isabgol

The farmers training on good agricultural practices on cumin and isabgol have been organized under the DBT funded project "Establishing of Biotech –KISAN Hub (Western Dry region's Aspirational districts of Jaisalmer) at Chandan Experimental farm of ICAR-CAZRI, RRS Jaisalmer on 13th February 2024. A total of one hundred farmers have participated in this training program. Dr. R.S. Mehta, briefed about the project and highlighted about importance of adopting good agricultural practices for getting quality cumin and isabgol production.
