Farmers training cum exposure visit programme under SCSP scheme at CAZRI, RRS, <u>Jaisalmer</u>

One day training on "Improved cultivation practices of kharif crops" cum exposure visit programme for farmers was organized on 08.09.2022 by ICAR-CAZRI, RRS, Jaisalmer under SCSP scheme. Dr. Anil Patidar explained improved cultivation practices for grasses specially Sewan and Dhaman, and also emphasized on plantation of multipurpose trees and horticultural plants in field and boundary for arid region. Dr. Saranya R. explained the control measure of diseases like root rot and tikka disease in Ground nut, and blight in Guar. Along with this training programme, farmers were also visited to nursery, crop cafeteria, and experimental trial of Mateera, Guar and Bajra. They also visited to Grasses, Ber, Guggle, Karonda and Grewia blocks at herbal garden of RRS Jaisalmer. Farmers were very happy by seeing different varieties of Ground nut, Moong, Moth and Guar in crop cafeteria at same place. They were also appreciated the seedling of different trees and shrubs in nursery specially Moringa and Guggle.
