Prof. Ramesh Chand, Member, NITI Ayog visits CAZRI, Jodhpur

Professor Ramesh Chand, Member, NITI Ayog visited the Central Arid Zone Research Institute (CAZRI), Jodhpur on 10th March, 2017. He delivered a talk on "Emerging trends in agricultural and rural economy of India" and deliberated on doubling farmers' income by 2022.
