Celebration of World Soil Day

World Soil Day was organized by CAZRI Krishi Vigyan Kendra, at village Palari Ranwata on 5 Dec., 2016. Programme was inaugurated by Chief Guest Sh. Chiman Singh Ji Dedu, Pradhan of Panchayat Samiti Bhopalgarh, Jodhpur. Soil health cards were distributed to farmers on this occasion.
